Directions for St John's Seminary.

St John's Seminary is situated on the B2128 on the road between Guildford and Cranleigh, about 4 miles from Guildford. (Grid Ref: TQ024450)

From Guildford.

Leave Guildford on the A281 Horsham road. (Debenham's store and Yvonne Arnaud theatre to the right are good landmarks). Follow this road to Shalford, where you cross the railway.

At Shalford village green turn left onto the B2128 towards Cranleigh. Do not turn off this road. (This may also be signposted A248 Dorking.) Follow this road through Wonersh village, past the Grantley Arms, where the road bears sharply left. As you exit the village the road rises. The entrance to St John's is on the left some 50 yds after the brow of the hill, just by a 30mph reminder sign.

From A3 (Compton)

Exit A3 at Compton and take the B3000 Godalming road Eastwards through Compton. Continue on this road, past the entrance to the Loseley Estate. At the roundabout after Guildford Crematorium turn Left towards Guildford and then right at the next roundabout towards Shalford. In Shalford turn left onto the A281 and then right at the roundabout onto the B2128 Cranleigh road. Do not turn off this road. (This may also be signposted A248 Dorking.) Follow this road through Wonersh village, past the Grantley Arms, where the road bears sharply left. As you exit the village the road rises. The entrance to St John's is on the left some 50 yds after the brow of the hill, just by a 30mph reminder sign.

The Seminary may also be approached from the nearby villages of Cranleigh or Bramley. The easiest access however is to be found approaching from Wonersh village.

By Public Transport.

By train to Guildford. Then from Guildford Bus Station (Friary Centre) take Arriva bus service for Cranleigh / Horsham and ask for a ticket for the Seminary (53/63). It is probably best to move to the front just after the stop in Wonersh at the Grantley Arms. There are usually a few buses each hour during the day, and the service runs into the evening. See www.arrivabus.co.uk for timetables.

A taxi from Guildford station costs about £10.
